

RESOLUTION NO. 20-06

A RESOLUTION OF CUSTER COUNTY, A POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OF THE STATE OF COLORADO, HEREBY CREATES A JUSTICE CENTER FUND TO BE ESTABLISHED AND MAINTAINED BY THE CUSTER COUNTY TREASURER.

WHEREAS, the County is setting aside funds to meet future financial obligations for the construction of a Justice Center; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has been advised by the auditor to hold these funds in the General Fund, of which the beginning balance of said fund shall be established by a resolution of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the identification of recurring revenue streams will be determined at the time of establishing such fund; and

WHEREAS, the identification of non-recurring revenue streams will be determined on an on-going basis; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has determined that such funds designated for the purpose set forth above shall be used for no other purpose;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

1. The Custer County Treasurer shall create a new account known as the Justice Center Fund;
2. All funds presently held by the County Treasurer for the proposed Justice Center, excluding any 2020 expended budgeted funds, shall be transferred into said Justice Center Fund;
3. The beginning balance of the Justice Center Fund shall be established at \$35,801;
4. The recurring revenue stream for said fund shall be established as \$1,600.00 per month generated by the monthly revenue from the AT&T lease agreement,
5. Other revenue streams for said account shall be established as the Board of County Commissioners deems appropriate;

6. Expenditures from the Justice Center Fund shall be authorized by the Board of County Commissioners during a special or regularly held Commissioner meeting;

7. If the Board of County Commissioners determines in the future that the Justice Center fund is no longer necessary, such action to disburse monies from said fund shall only be accomplished by a Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners.
