

August 14, 2025 Stage 2 Fire Restrictions Now in Effect - Custer County

After consultation with the Wet Mountain Fire Protection District Fire Chief and a thorough review of current fire danger conditions and the lack of available mutual aid resources, Sheriff and Fire Warden Rich Smith has implemented **Stage 2 Fire Restrictions** for **Custer County**, effective immediately on **August 14, 2025**.

Under Stage 2 Fire Restrictions, the following activities are prohibited by statute:

- Campfires
- Open burning
- Use of fireworks, explosive targets, model rockets.
- Outdoor smoking
- Welding or operating acetylene or similar torches with an open flame, unless in a cleared area free of vegetation. Must have fire extinguisher or water supply.
- Operation of internal combustion engines without a properly installed and functioning spark arrestor. Must have fire extinguisher or water supply.
- Prescribed burns
 (Any previously issued permits are now revoked.)

These restrictions will remain in effect until modified as specified in Custer County Resolution 18-17.

These fire restrictions do not apply to the US Forrest Service or BLM which have not issued a fire restriction. However, users of these public lands should use extreme caution.
