Dear Custer County Commissioners:

We are pleased to announce the approval of the Custer County Multi-Government Hazard Mitigation Plan as meeting the requirements of the Stafford Act and Title 44 Code of Federal Regulations 201.6 for a local hazard mitigation plan. The plan approval extends to Custer County.

The County is hereby eligible for FEMA Hazard Mitigation Assistance grant programs. All requests for funding will be evaluated individually according to the specific eligibility and other requirements of the particular programs under which the application is submitted. Approved mitigation plans may be eligible for points under the National Flood Insurance Program Community Rating System.

The plan is approved through April 12, 2028. A local jurisdiction must revise its plan and resubmit it for approval within five years to continue to be eligible for mitigation project grant funding. We have provided recommendations for the next plan update on the enclosed Plan Review Tool.

We wish to thank the County for participating in the process and commend your continued commitment to mitigation planning. 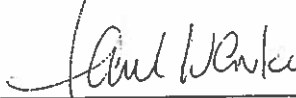
WHEREAS, the Town of Westcliffe has reviewed the Plan and affirms participation with Custer County in updating the Plan no less than every five (5) years.

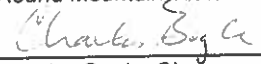

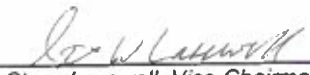

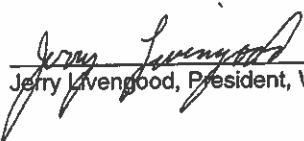
