The Local Emergency Planning Committee (LEPC) is hosting a meeting on Thursday, November 16, 2023 at 10am at the Custer County Search and Rescue Building (710 Rosita Ave, Westcliffe, CO 81252). This meeting is open to the public and virtually (see meeting information below). The goal of the meeting is to discuss and educate about the hazardous materials and ways to plan for mitigation and response.

The LEPC is a countywide committee tasked with identifying hazardous materials within the county. In addition, the LEPC works with Custer County Office of Emergency Management to prepare and create emergency response plans. It is the goal of the LEPC is to identify risks/hazards which may create a disaster. The LEPC facilitates communications, works on strategies, develops plans, coordinates training and conducts practice drills.

Congress implemented EPCRA (Emergency Planning and Community Right-to-Know Act) to help communities plan for chemical emergencies. It requires industry to report the storage, use, and releases of certain chemicals to federal, state, tribal, territorial and/or local governments. It also requires for these reports to be used to prepare for and protect their communities from potential risk.
