

Custer County Department of Human Services is accepting applications for a GENERALIST CHILD WELFARE/ADULT PROTECTION SUPERVISOR to provide services in the areas of child abuse and neglect, and adult protection.

Under the supervision of the Human Services Director, the Child Welfare/Adult Protection Supervisor provides leadership, direction, and overall administrative oversight to the adult and family services programs of the Custer County Department of Human Services. Program areas include child welfare, adult protection, family engagement, and foster and adoption program management. Duties include fiscal management and grant application management, contracting, program and policy implementation and submission of all children and family services. This position promotes the vision, mission, and practices for the programs and leads the integration of service delivery with regional stakeholders. Manages staff and coordinates workload issues to ensure effective programming and service delivery. Provides outreach and education to other community agencies, and develops positive relationships and partnerships. Participates in various state committees and meetings. This position is responsible for compliance with State and Department policies and relevant Federal, state and local laws, rules, regulations, codes and/or statutes. They will be able to show a thorough understanding of completing Child/Adult Protection investigations, providing ongoing services to families/at risk adults, may carry a caseload, and will be part of an on-call schedule. This position is involved with community partners, the Courts, and other professionals.

Applicant must have a valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and full coverage car insurance as travel within Colorado for meetings/training is required. Applicants must possess a Bachelor's Degree in the field of Social Work or a related behavioral science field. Applicants must have 3 or more years of case practice experience in Child Welfare or Adult Protection Services. If not already certified, the applicant will be required to successfully complete the Colorado Child Welfare Supervisor's Academy and the Colorado Adult Protective Services Supervisor training. Drug Testing and Background Checks are required. Starting salary will be dependent on experience. Competitive benefits package included. The deadline to apply is July 28, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. Applicants need to include a copy of their college transcripts, references and a resume with the application.
