PERMITS REQUIRED FOR CUSTER COUNTY SHORT TERM RENTALS

WESTCLIFFE, CO. (JULY 2021) - The Custer County Board of County Commissioners enacted a Zoning Resolution, on March 30, 2021, which requires a permit to operate any Short-Term Rental. During the public meeting, all active Short-Term Rental owners were granted a permit grace period to continue renting until January 1, 2022. Anyone who was operating a Short-Term Rental in the unincorporated area of Custer County prior to March 30, 2021, must apply for a Short-Term Rental permit before November 11, 2021. The deadline is set to ensure that planning and zoning has ample time to complete inspections, process applications and present permit requests for approval at 2021's final planning and zoning commission meeting.

Individuals or businesses adding their property or residence(s) to the Short-term Rental market after March 30, 2021, must have a permit before rentals can begin. Applications for Short-Term Rental permits are available at the Custer County Planning and Zoning Office, 205 S 6th St, Westcliffe.
